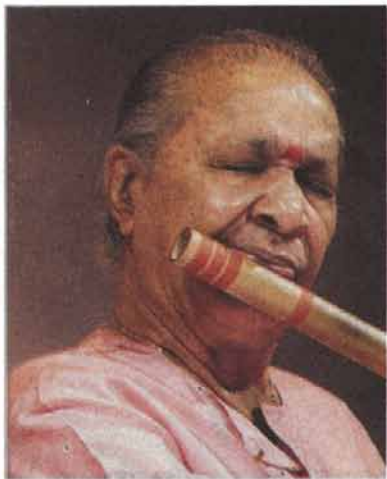


A festival of music and dance
