

Isha Vidhya to produce two lakh saplings for Cauvery Calling

Nine Isha Vidhya schools in the State will be producing two lakh saplings in the next one year for Cauvery Calling.

A sapling training session was held here recently at Isha Vidhya Matriculation Higher Secondary School to train 100 students from the nine schools who in turn will train 100 students from each of the schools. Swami Rabhya, co-ordinator, Isha Project Green-Hands, conducted the training in which students from Isha Vidhya schools from Coimbatore, Erode, Mettur, Karur, Dharmapuri, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Nagercoil, and Thoothukudi participated.

An agro farm will be developed and maintained in all the nine schools by students where saplings such as red sandalwood, sandalwood, teak and Indian Kino tree (Venkai), beneficial for farmers' economy and the environment will be produced. The saplings will then be distributed to farmers for transplantation in their own farmlands.
